MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Petitioner, through his undersigned counsel, moves this Court for an immediate temporary restraining order prohibiting respondents, or any of their subordinates, from transferring or deploying him outside the jurisdiction of this Court pending a final order in this matter. As grounds, he states:

1. Petitioner has filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus alleging that respondents are going to move him to the jurisdiction of the Multi-National Division Baghdad (MNDB) in Iraq to be court martialed for alleged threats he made while a member of the United States Army stationed in Fort Stewart, Georgia within the jurisdiction of this Court.

2. The petition for writ of habeas corpus alleges significant deprivations of
